Please ensure that your nomination form is completed by **Wednesday 17 September**.

The judges will review the submitted information to determine the award winner. The winners will be announced during the ceremony in Sheffield on 17 November. This award recognises community energy organisations in England that demonstrate outstanding commitment to community engagement and inclusion, innovative approaches in the community energy sector, and/or have made significant progress in scaling their impact over the 2024/2025 period. To be eligible for this award, the organisation must have a turnover of £0 - 100,000.

In order to nominate your organisation for this award, please prepare answers and clearly demonstrate as many of the following as possible:

1. Evidence of progress in expanding impact, reach, or operational scale
2. Use of innovative methods in service delivery, project development, fundraising, partnerships, community engagement, or business models
3. Clear, measurable examples of significant positive change or benefit to the community
4. Inclusive engagement strategies

5. Commitment to learning, reflection, and refinement of strategies
6. Sharing learning and expertise
